

# TAPATAN

3 in a now thinking game from The Philippines

### What you need:

- -Game board. Draw 6 inch square with bisecting lines
- -Three counters per player

### **Objective:**

To be the first player to get 3 in a row (like in tic tac toe). A row can be made horizontally, vertically or diagonally.

### **Rules:**

There are two phases of the game. In the "drop phase" players place their pieces on the board. In the move phase, players move their pieces in an attempt to get 3 in a row.

### The Drop Phase:

Players take turns placing their counters on the board on a point until all counters have been placed.

#### The Move Phase:

Once all counters are on the board, players take turns moving their counters from one point at a time in an attempt to get 3 in a row. No jumping is allowed.

Counters can only move to adjacent, empty points.

The first player to move his counters into a row of 3 is the winner.

### How to Make Lu-lu Dice



- What you need:
  - -Four "dice" for each player. Each dice has a quantity from 1-4 showing on one side only. The opposite side is blank.
  - -A pen and paper for each player
  - -A small cup (optional)
  - -2 or more players.

### Objective:

To be the first player to reach 100.

### **Rules:**

- -Each player gets two tosses per turn.
- -The first player tosses his four dice down on the table. Optional: shake dice in small cup before throwing them down.
- -Next, he picks up any dice which landed face down (*no points showing*) and tosses them again.
- -If all the dice land face up, he is allowed to pick all the dice up for his second throw. The maximum score for one turn is 20 (*two perfect throws*).
- -Count the total points showing and record on score sheet. Play until one player reaches 100.

# Tag games

### Freeze Tag:

One player is It. When a player is tagged, he must remain frozen in place. He can be unfrozen if he is tagged by a non-It player. When all the players are frozen, a new It is chosen, and play begins again.

### **Tunnel Tag:**

One player is It. When a player is tagged, he must remain frozen in place, with his legs spread apart, creating a tunnel. He can be unfrozen if a non-It player crawls under the leg tunnel. When all the players are frozen, a new It is chosen, and play begins again.

### Band-Aid Tag:

One player is It. When a player is tagged he puts a hand (as a "band-aid") over the spot where It touched him. When he is tagged a second time, he places the other hand on the new spot. When he is tagged a third time, he becomes It.

### Turtle Tag:

One person is It. If a chased player get tagged, she becomes frozen until she is tagged by another non-It player. To avoid being tagged, players can lay down on their backs with their hands and feet in the air. Players can only remain safe like this for 10 seconds.

### Toilet Tag: (You read that right)

One person is It. When a player is tagged, he must squat down, as if on a toilet, and hold one hand out to the side like a handle. He can become un-frozen when a non-It player flushes the "handle" while making a "wooosh" sound. When all the players are frozen, a new It is chosen, and play begins again. Expect a lot of giggling.
